
COVID-19 Safety Guidelines for Sacred Fire Asheville Events

The firekeeper or event host will walk you through a process to help us connect while prioritizing everyone's safety. Physical distancing and face covering requirements remain in effect. Please stay at home if you have symptoms consistent with COVID-19, or have been in contact with someone who has COVID-19 within 2 weeks of the event.

- Wear your face mask (no scarves or fleece) when you arrive and when you cannot maintain at least six (6) feet distance from other people (with the exception of family or household members).



-No hugging or kissing. Give and receive love from afar or from a 🔥 .

- Chairs are provided (you can bring your own) and will be 6 feet apart - couples or families will have seats together. If doors to the council house are open or if we are completely outside, you have the option of removing your mask once seated. As the colder weather arrives, we may close the council doors in which case face coverings will be required.

- Arrive early to connect with the forest, rocky cliffs and Ivy river. Immerse yourself in nature - 2 miles of trails are waiting for you. Out of respect and care, please keep physically distanced from others and respect the privacy of guests staying at our vacation rental (Trail time). Trailhead and maps are at the woodshed in the parking area. Hike at your own risk.

- For the time being, refrain from using tobacco around the fire. It can lead to coughing and increase the spread of germs. You may smoke outside the group area.

- Bring your own water or beverage. We will not be passing snacks at the fire.



- An outhouse with hand sanitizer is available near the council house.

- Unfortunately, we are not offering camping on the land this year. There are plenty of AirBnBs/ VRBOs, hotels and friends in the area, as well as public/private campgrounds..
